The California Crime and Intelligence Analysts' Association (CCIAA) is issuing a call for speakers/presentations for the 2022 California Crime and Intelligence Analysts' Association training conference. Individuals interested in speaking at the conference are requested to submit a proposal to the conference committee by July 29, 2022.

Proposals are to be one page or less and include full contact information for each speaker (including name, agency, address, phone, and e-mail), a brief biography of the speaker, session synopsis, and logistic needs.

Sessions are sixty minutes in length. However, arrangements can be made for multiple sessions if needed.

Speakers must be available and willing to speak on any day and at any time slot during the conference.

The committee will evaluate each proposal and select the ones that best represent the needs of the attendees. Speakers/presenters will be notified prior to the conference.

Presenters will be given 1 night at the hotel. For each additional presentation, each presenter will get \$100 off registration.

Note – Budgetary restrictions may factor in final decisions.
