You will get a close look into the Aryan Brotherhood, Nazi Low Riders, Peckerwoods, local gangs including Public Enemy Number One, Orange County Skins, Gestapo Boys/Skins, HB Hardcore, La Miranda Punks and more. In addition, you will delve into ideological groups including KKK in Orange County as well as other hate groups/gangs including RAM (Rise Above Movement) Proud Boys, Traditionalist Worker's Party, Hammerskins, WAR, and cover Antifa and sovereign citizens.

Brett Amrhein: (Deputy Probation Officer) Employed with the Orange County Probation Department for 16 years. Past 7 years assigned to AB109/Postrelease Community Supervision Division (PCS). For the past several years I have worked a specialized assignment supervising white racist gang (WRG) members on AB109/Mandatory Supervision/Probation supervision. These WRG's include AB, NLR, PEN1, OCS, Gestapo, WAR, HB Hardcore, La Mirada Punks and many more. Over the course of my career I have conducted hundreds of interviews with WRG members. I am a certified training expert in the area of white racist gangs and regularly conduct department training for the Orange County Probation Department regarding current WRG gang updates, trends, and officer safety issues.

Advanced Gang Intelligence  
LAPD Curtis Davis

Curtis Davis will be speaking on two topics: criminal intelligence (in general), including how to make gang intelligence more defensible in a post-CalGANG audit world, and online/open source intelligence.

Curtis Davis has been with the Los Angeles Police Department for 16 years. His assignments include a Gang Enforcement Detail, Special Problems Unit, and Crime & Intelligence Analysis Detail, and he is currently assigned to Robbery-Homicide Division. Davis graduated with a degree in Intelligence Management from Henley-Putnam University, where he obtained a National Military Intelligence Foundation scholarship. He has collateral duties as a POST ICI instructor and Terrorism Liaison Officer, and was one of two LAPD members of the State Anti-Gang Intelligence Network (SAGIN). Davis is currently a member of the Society of Police Futurists International, the Association of Social Media and Online Investigators, and the Association of Former Intelligence Officers' Speakers Bureau. He currently teaches at LA HIDTA Training Center on Intelligence-Led Policing and Open Source Intelligence (classes are available online, on-demand from www.instruq.co). Davis is especially passionate about post-9/11 law enforcement information-sharing. He believes that technology can enhance – but never replace – good old-fashioned police work.
