It enables agencies to efficiently separate the wheat from the chaff within minimal time. Jim Rowley will be discussing how users can manage vast amounts of information from various sources using AI, how to profile various types of social media platforms, blogs, forums and websites and how to expose social connections, groups and inciters. Additionally, Jim will show how users can access hidden and limited information from the web and maintain anonymity using untraceable worldwide proxy infrastructure.
