Facial Recognition: This class will cover the use of facial recognition as an investigative resource. Emphasis will be on what makes a quality probe image, facial comparison techniques (facial identification), the documentation and presentation of findings, facial recognition as a generator of “investigative leads only”, some courtroom experiences, and stories from the trenches. This class is not a how-to on how to use the LA County or any other FR system, but an overview of lessons learned after 7 years of FR experience and approximately 4000 FR searches.

Adobe Bridge: The Adobe Bridge product allows you to see the full image of your PDFs rather than a thumbnail and within the program, you can use it to sort based on keywords that can be useful when tagging crime trends. You can edit the metadata, add keywords, labels, preview, organize, edit and easily publish your products quickly.
